

CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS — at least 16 fatalities since July 1

Fatal Cases due to heroin/fentanyl in May-at least 41 (15 cases pending additional testing)

- 27 City of Cleveland Residents
- 14 Suburban Residents- Brooklyn, Lakewood, Maple Hts. (2), Mayfield Hts., Parma (3), 1 Unknown and
- (5) Out of County Brunswick (2), Elyria, Grafton, and Ottawa.

VICTIMS

Victims' ages range from 23 – 68

30 Male victims; 11 Female victims

5 African American victims; 36 Caucasian victims (5 Hispanic victims)


TRENDS


At least **301** victims have died from heroin/fentanyl/analog or in combination in 2017. This compares to 213 through end of June 2016. Drug deaths in 2017 total at least **373** fatalities when including cocaine as well.

Carfentanil: 58 CONFIRMED FATAL CASES in 2016; 12 in 2017


Rate of African American deaths involving fentanyl is 20.2% of all victims, nearly double the rate of 2016 (14.5%). At least 36 cocaine related deaths occurred in June (at least 187 for 2017), with 18 being mixed with Fentanyl, Heroin or both (at least 107 for the year).














Cuyahoga County Heroin Related Overdose Deaths 2007-2017* Projected deaths with DAWN Saves and Fentanyl as overdose Deaths
